Skyline Tower

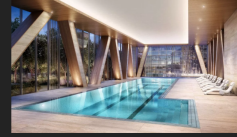

One West End

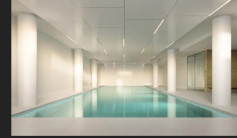

90 Morton

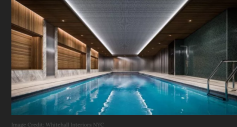
